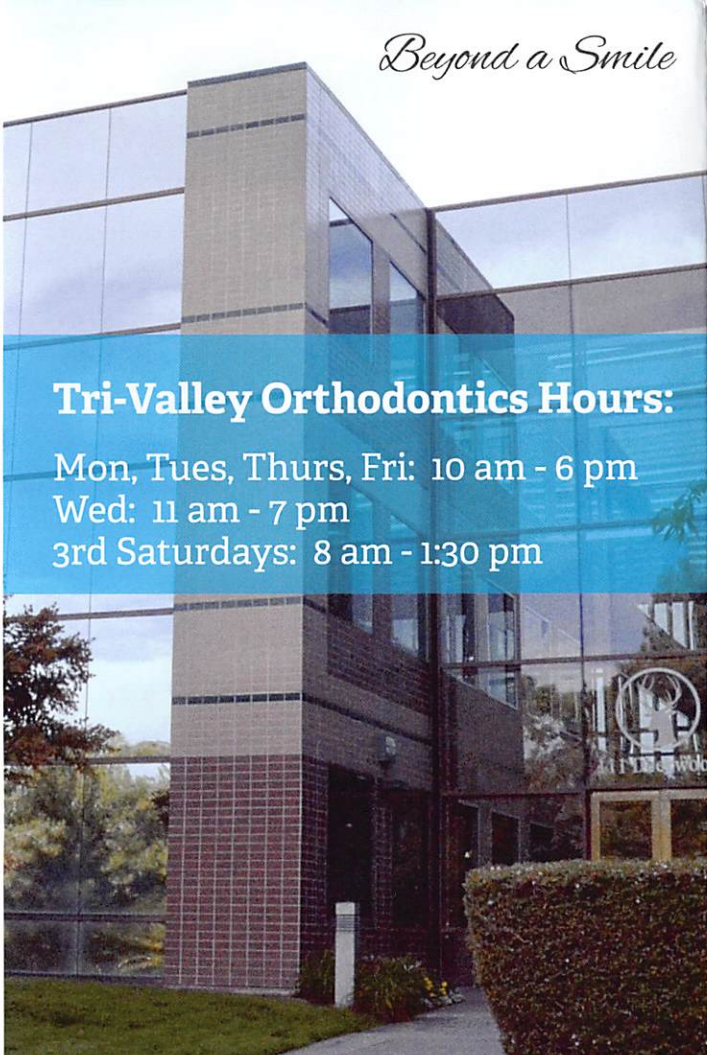
Meet Dr. Anne Yoon

Only after this formal education can one be called an Orthodontist. Orthodontists must limit their practice to orthodontics only.



When should I bring my child in for their first visit?

The American Association of Orthodontists recommends that kids come in for their first exam at age 7. This exam is to ensure that skeletal & dental development is normal.

Many kids won't need braces at this early age. If we notice a problem that is causing trauma or could hinder normal development, then early treatment will be recommended.

This will allow us to correct the problem during a period of active growth - reducing both trauma & the likelihood of further complications in adolescence.

We offer a variety of treatment options which we customize for you following your consultation:

Metal Braces - are still the standard in orthodontic care due to their superior control of tooth movement & treatment efficacy. We provide our patients with low-profile metal brackets which are much smaller & sleeker in shape, increasing comfort & aesthetics. We also offer self-ligating braces & aesthetic white gold braces.

Clear (Ceramic) Braces - are a great choice for those who desire the efficacy and control of traditional braces along with a higher degree of aesthetics during their orthodontic treatment.



Lingual (Invisible) Braces - are bonded to the back surfaces of your teeth allowing us to align your teeth without any visible braces or aligners. This is an increasingly popular option for our eligible adult patients.

SureSmile & Invisalign - are a series of clear plastic removable trays which gradually move your teeth into alignment.
